

alignment is pictured in yellow on this map. It would be 130 feet wide in both the initial and ultimate configurations. The initial four-lane configuration, which could be constructed in the near term to accommodate traffic through 2035, would provide two travel lanes, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes in each direction. The ultimate six-lane configuration, which could be constructed in the future to accommodate traffic through 2050, would provide three travel lanes, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes in each direction.



Structural crossings for vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians would also be constructed over the Beardsley Canal and McMicken Wash. The concepts are a single-span bridge over the Beardsley Canal just south of Jomax Road, and a reinforced concrete box culvert over McMicken Wash, located south of Happy Valley Road. The public input gathered during this phase of the project will inform the Design Concept Report and Environmental Assessment (EA) that are currently being prepared.

A <u>virtual public hearing</u> for the draft EA is anticipated for summer 2025.

The project team will share details when they are confirmed.
