

Project Update

Fieldwork scheduled to begin March 10 at Beardsley Canal, McMicken Wash

Some residents might see crews, equipment nearby

Geotechnical fieldwork is scheduled to begin on **Monday, March 10, 2025**, at the Beardsley Canal and McMicken Wash, meaning some nearby residents could see workers and heavy equipment near their homes on weekdays for the next one to two weeks. The fieldwork is occurring in conjunction with the project to prepare a Design Concept Report (DCR) and Environmental Assessment (EA) for proposed improvements to El Mirage Road between Loop 303 and Jomax Road.

Field crews will not access individual private properties. All fieldwork is scheduled to occur between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Workers will temporarily use large drilling rigs to collect samples of underground materials, such as rocks and soil, for a geotechnical analysis. The results of geotechnical analysis will help inform design and construction of the structural crossings over the Beardsley Canal, located just south of Jomax Road, and McMicken Wash, located south
